Student Laptop Roll-out March 2017

A key strategic focus of Tyndale Christian School is providing student-centred, access anytime/anywhere learning as well as core skills in general Information, Communication and Technology (ICT) competence. We recognise that technology is a key enabler in this pursuit and the School has progressively improved and increased the use of computers and other related devices.

In 2017 the School will launch this initiative by releasing the first round of 1:1 devices to **all students in Years 10 and 11**. Students will be given a school-owned laptop which will be taken home. We will be running information sessions and collection opportunities where parents and students will find out more details, pick up your student's device, and take care of formalities. An SMS will be sent to you providing a link to our website where you will find copies of the Device Agreement and Acceptable Use Agreement to help you prepare and understand the responsibilities of students, parents/caregivers and the School.

There is no cost to parents/caregivers for these devices (unless there is loss or damage) as the cost is already incorporated into school fees.

We recommend you read through the student agreement with your child and talk to them about their responsibilities and how they will care for the technology. We require you to attend one of the information and collection sessions. Before a device can be issued, it is required that both Agreements are signed and given to the School at the time of collection.
